

East Suffolk Line Walks

Walk 19 Part 1 Wickham Market Station to Framlingham



Route revision August 2016 to avoid broken footbridge at Hacheston (Approx. TM 309592)

Key Point 6

From the entrance to the churchyard at Marlesford continue along the road to where it makes a sharp right bend. The path starts left through a metal chain stile to follow Pound Lane for about 1/4 mile, ignoring three gates on the right. Opposite a small hut branch right off the lane to follow a path up rising ground at the side of woodland.

Keep ahead until meeting a farm track at right angles. Turn left, keeping direction where the main track turns left into fields and continue along a grassy lane between hedges.

At the end of the lane a waymark post at the base of a large tree shows where to turn right along the edge of a field for a short distance. The path bears left a little way before striking out half right (north) across a large arable field.

The cross-field path is usually marked out, passing to the right of an isolated oak tree and beyond skirting a tree-lined pond, eventually bearing left and becoming a once-concreted farm track. Ignore a wide farm track off to the right and head generally west along the track at the side of a substantial ditch towards modern farm buildings with an expansive concrete pad. At a farmyard junction of tracks the route continues ahead towards Moat Hall Farm and **Key Point 9**

The revised route is approximately half a mile shorter than the route via Hacheston.
